



## 2023 Local Improvement Projects – C2023-0302

## RECOMMENDATION(S):

That Council:

- Approve an increase of \$4,576,713.35 in 2023 budget appropriation to Public Services Delivery Capital Program 147-148, totaling \$4,576,713.35; and
- Give three readings to Bylaw 1R2023.

## Background

- Local Improvement Bylaws are presented to Council annually to authorize the financing, and construction of the lane paving and driveway crossings in residential areas.
- In March 2022, Council approved the previous Bylaw 1R2022.

## Highlights

- Local Improvements are projects that Council considers to be a greater benefit to a particular area in the municipality than to the whole municipality.
- All the projects associated with this Bylaw were initiated or requested by property owners.
- There is no cost sharing between The City and property owners, all costs are charged to the property owners.

## Discussion

- Notices of intention to undertake 53 Local Improvement projects were sent to affected property owners.
- Petitions Against were requested and sent out for 7 projects. There was one petition against that was returned and was invalid.
