Since July 2010 I have resided and own my residence at 2440 31 Street S. W. directly behind the alley to the proposed 4 duplex for oricatw entrances upstairs and downstairs to each of these 4 units. That means a minimum 8 people in each of these units and if each has someone living with them whether it be a partner or relative possibly 16 individuals living in the new 4 plex. Each of these individuals could own a car that would mean 8 -16 vehicles to park in 4 designated parking stall garages. I am strongly opposed for the following reasons 1) Safety of children across the street in that intersection with increased traffic and parking of new residents in the new 4 plex and parents trying to drop off and pick up their children at the TWO DAY CARES AT THE INTERSECTION where this 4 plex us being built is an accident waiting to happen!! 2) Limited parking in front of my property to accommodate new residents and parents dropping and up kids at day care. 3) Residents in Killarney have already made complaints regarding similar complexes built within blocks regarding limited bins for garbage, recycling and organic matter soulling over and scattered in the alley ways and using the next door neighbor's bins!! Not environmentally friendly that's for sure 4) Will I be able to easily park my car in my garage if there is double parking in my back alley PLUS garbage/ recycling and green bin debris scattered throughout my back alley?
