- Hears and determines appeals of business licences, remedial orders, and other Bylaw Orders
- ▶ 10 public members panels typically consist of 5 members, quorum is 3

Some Board members require experience in animal behaviour as per the Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw


Key Accomplishments

- Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw
 - The Board has expanded to 10 members from 5 to hear appeals from this Bylaw
 - Board now includes registered veterinarians and dog trainers/behaviour consultants

 Development of guidelines for the acceptance of digital materials as part of submissions

Challenges

- Low number of appeals
- Bylaw Enforcement's objective is compliance rather than prosecution
- Current increase in volume of appeals owing to expanded mandate

Work Plan for 2023

- Providing an opportunity for Calgarians to have their position heard by an independent tribunal on decisions that have been made against them by the City Administration
- The Board continues to look for improvements to the Procedures to make the process less intimidating for Appellants
