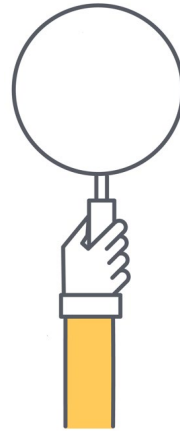

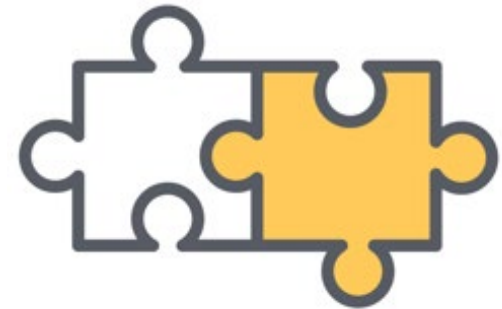
# Mandate of the Social Wellbeing Advisory Committee

- Aim to stop social problems before they begin using a prevention approach

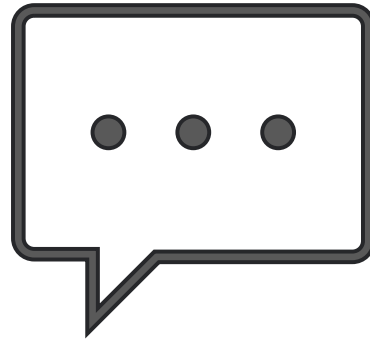
# Highlights from the Annual Report

- 10 Committee meetings since May 2022
  - 9 Subcommittee meetings
- Provided advice on 17 strategies, policies and events spanning 10 business units and 2 external partners
