Context

On November 15, 2021 Calgary City Council declared a Climate Emergency. This formalized The City's support for emergency action to respond to climate change, and recognized the pace and scale of action needed. The subsequent approval of the Calgary Climate Strategy – Pathways to 2050 and its Implementation Plan provide clear direction on where integration of climate change must occur along the planning approvals continuum, including the Land Use Bylaw. This direction is further illustrated in the Growth and Development Climate Framework (EC2023-0140) of which Council received a status update on 2023 April 25.
