Funding recommendations vary from one to three years.

- One year of funding is recommended for organizations that require more time to address challenging governance situations and/or to demonstrate their alignment to evidence-based practice. Where Administration recommends conditions accompany funding, those are marked in the column called "Conditions Endnote #" to the left of the agency name.
- A two-year funding recommendation applies to organizations that received conditional funding in 2013 and have met their conditions satisfactorily.
- A three-year funding recommendation is made for strong organizations with good governance structures and exemplary programming.

For 2014, 77 agencies requested \$36,383,010 for an available \$31,403,956, resulting in a gap of \$6,398,594. This represents only requests submitted from FCSS currently funded agencies.
