

Leveraging City Land for Affordable Housing

Recommendations

That the Community Development Committee recommend that Council:

- Direct Administration to advance the Land for Affordable Housing Action Plan as attached; and
- 2. Approve the proposed amendments to the Non-Market Housing Land Disposition Policy CP2019-02.

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Review of all City parcels

Very few City-owned sites available.

 Administration reviewed all surplus City-owned parcels.

• From that review, only 2 available parcels for release in the Non-Market Housing Land Sale program.

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Land for Affordable Housing Action Plan

- Expand the scope of existing programs to prioritize affordable housing outcomes.
- Create a Housing Land Fund through 2024 budget adjustments.
- Amend Council policy to release land for Indigenous housing.
- Promote temporary use of City-owned land expected to sit vacant for 10+ years.
- Identify surplus City-owned land along Transit Corridors for affordable housing.





Non-Market Housing Land Disposition Policy





- Advances Truth & Reconciliation; responds directly to engagement with Indigenous people.
- Amendments to policy: land specifically for Indigenous housing.
- Builds capacity in the Indigenous housing community; allows for a For Indigenous-By-Indigenous approach.

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
