2023 Calgary Awards Recipient - W.O. Mitchell Book Prize

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That Council:

- 1. Ratify the 2023 Calgary Awards Recipient for the W.O. Mitchell Book Prize as recommended by the selection jury (Attachment 1); and
- 2. Direct that Attachment 1 remain confidential pursuant to Section 17 (Disclosure harmful to personal privacy) of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* until after the Calgary Awards ceremony on 2023 June 14.

HIGHLIGHTS

- The Calgary Awards are The City of Calgary's ("The City") highest honour. 13 different Calgary Awards celebrate and recognize outstanding achievements and contributions made by Calgarians.
- 12 of the 13 Calgary Awards Recipients were ratified by Council at the 2023 March 14 Regular Meeting of Council (C2023-0005). The final Calgary Awards recipient to be ratified is for the W.O. Mitchell Book Prize.
- What does this mean to Calgarians? The Calgary Awards are an opportunity for Calgarians to nominate deserving individuals, businesses, and organizations to be recognized by The City.
- Why does this matter? The W.O. Mitchell Book Prize is awarded in honour of acclaimed Calgary writer W.O. Mitchell and recognizes literary achievement by Calgary authors.
- Strategic Alignment to Council's Guiding Principles: Strengthen Relationships with Calgarians.
- Background and Previous Council Direction are included in Attachment 2.

DISCUSSION

Section 5.7.3 of Council's *Recognitions by Council Policy*, CP2018-2, requires that Calgary Awards "recipients are to be selected by a jury from amongst nominations and ratified by Council."

The W.O. Mitchell Book Prize is coordinated through a partnership between The City and the Writers' Guild of Alberta, which administers the Award as part of the Alberta Literary Competitions. A total of 42 submissions were accepted from 2022 October 11 to December 31.

Members of the W.O. Mitchell Book Prize Jury ("the Jury") received the book submissions to read in 2023 January, then met from 2023 March 17 to 31 to make their decision. The Jury selected the Calgary Awards W.O. Mitchell Book Prize Recipient as listed in confidential Attachment 1. Information about the Jury is provided in Attachment 3.
