
## **Protest Trends**


Protests in Calgary are monitored weekly by the Emergency Management & Community Safety business unit at The City of Calgary, in coordination with other City departments and the Calgary Police Service.

Figure 1 (below) shows the number of total weekly protests that have occurred in Calgary in 2023 as well as specified protests taking place at recreation centres and libraries, and unrelated protests.

Figure 2 (below) shows the actual number of weekly specified protests that have taken place at recreation centres and libraries in 2023, along with the number of forecasted specified protests<sup>1</sup>. After the Safe and Inclusive Access bylaw was passed on March 14, 2023, the number of specified protests taking place at libraries and recreation centres has dropped to zero or one per week, which is lower than the forecasted three to four per week.
