- The proposed Terms of References for Joint Planning Area 1 and Joint Planning Area 2 will guide the creation of Context Studies and include:
 - roles and responsibilities;
 - regulatory framework;
 - dispute resolution; and
 - contents of the Context Study.






Joint Planning Areas
