


Harvie Passage Task Force – Final Report



Facility Enhancement Plan (FEP) Improvements

The purpose of the FEP is to develop a set of recommendations to guide the conceptual design and implementation strategy of park improvements.

Strategy & Recommendations

1. Safety Programming

Calgary

- Digital strategy and website content
- Coordinate education with enforcement
- Consider park ambassadors and lifeguards
- Emergency locator code signage

2. Vehicular Access & Parking Improvements

- Expand parking lot & enhance layout for trailers, loading, staging
- Improved access for transit, shuttle buses and food trucks
- Circulation signs and digital parking lot capacity signal

3. Pedestrian & Cyclist Circulation Improvements

- Pathway upgrades to separate walking and wheels
- Safer crossings and intersection design

4. Park Amenities

- Wayfinding, interpretive signage design unification
- Added seating, water fountains and other supporting day use amenities
- Playground upgrades for accessible standards

5. Park Facilities

- Temporary universal change stalls
- Existing washroom upgrades
- Scenarios for a boathouse facility
- An engineered wave for river surfing



Quick-Wins/Short Term Priority Items with Class 5 Cost Estimates

Quick-wins Approximate Investment Total:	\$915,000k
Existing Washroom Upgrades	\$375k
 Boathouse Finalize Scenarios & concept design 	\$60k
 Parking Lot Improvements, capacity signal & expansion 	\$250k
 Pathway Upgrades, safe crossings, signage, emergency locator code signage on riverbank both sides 	\$200k
 Temporary Universal Change Stalls (2) parking lot & riverside 	\$20k
 Sea-Can Storage & PFD Lending Station, public education & access pilot 	\$10k
