

**FB2002-11 TAX SUPPORTED CAPITAL FINANCING POLICY REVIEW as approved by Council, 2002 February 25:**

**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

- “8. New borrowing will not cause additional tax increases beyond those projected in the budget and without debt servicing exceeding 10% of gross expenditure (net of recoveries).”
- “10. On consideration of any borrowing bylaw, City Council will consider reports on:
- a) what attempts have been made to obtain funding from other orders of government;
  - b) The City of Calgary’s current and proposed debt situation in relation to compliance with this policy.”
