This Outline Plan's Connectivity Index is 2.0,         which should make walking easier and useful for residents of         this area.</li> <li>The Neighbourhood Activity Centre's placement in the middle         of the area, with larger parks nearby, could provide a centre of         gravity for neighbourhood activity. This may help foster         community more than pushing commercial cores and density         to busy streets along the perimeter of a neighbourhood. There         are also smaller pocket parks in other parts of the area so         residents also have public space closer to their homes.</li> </ul>
