Comments on Land Use Redesignation (Residual Sub-Area 02L)

As a resident and home owner from the community called Ambleton, which is right beside the zoning area mentioned in Residual Sub-Area 02L, I use the road a lot and I think to close that road would only generate negative impact on myself and my neighborhood.

Firstly, 144 Ave NW is a crucial road for people who live in my community doing their daily commute. It is the only road directly connected with the entrance of the whole Ambleton area. If that segment of 144 Ave get closed, people in my neighborhood have to detour from the Evanston Community. Because, we do not have any other roads connect to roads from eastern direction. Secondly, Ambleton is a small size community, which needs to utilize some facilities and commercial sources surround it. If that particular road close, then people from my community become hardly to reach the gas station, grocery stores and other facilities at eastern side(near carrington and livingston communities). Lastly, by definition, roads are very important facilities for people's daily life. As a citizen of Calgary, I prefer convenient daily commute experience, which definitely doesn't means close the only direct road toward to the eastern direction.
