Why do we need an Industrial Action Plan?

- Support and increase the **55,000 high quality jobs** (10% of total City of Calgary's jobs) associated with industrial
- Acknowledge and grow a sector that contributes
 15.15% of total tax revenue
- Identify and capitalize on opportunities that benefit municipal, regional, provincial, and national economies
- Helps articulate Council's ongoing support for industrial growth



Actions Completed in 2022





Removed regulatory barriers for businesses to open and operate in Calgary's industrial areas (Land Use Bylaw amendments)

Strengthened Municipal Development Plan policies to encouraged the retention of large industrial parcels

Identified infrastructure investments that support industrial growth



Actions Completed in 2022



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Evaluated solutions to Calgary's non-residential tax rate for the industrial sector

Improved the process to enable industrial developers to install services earlier in the development process

Redesignated public lands to industrial to accelerate development (313 hectares)

Improved awareness of Calgary's competitive advantages



Proposed Actions for 2023



Review the Nose Creek Area Structure Plan to explore a mix of uses without compromising its industrial importance

Pursue City-initiated amendments to modernize existing industrial Area Structure Plans


Explore alternative **funding and financing tools** for key transportation upgrades in strategic industrial areas

Evaluate potential **incentive opportunities** to support existing and new industrial development

Collaborate with Rocky View County on a **joint economic development framework** for an industrial growth corridor
