


# **Access Bylaw for 8775 – 17 Avenue SE, IP2023-0270**

May 10, 2023

### Recommendations

That the Infrastructure and Planning Committee recommends that Council:

- 1. Give three readings to the proposed Bylaw to remove the existing all-turns access for 8775 17 Avenue SE onto 17 Avenue SE (Attachment 1); and
- Direct Administration to modify the existing easterly access to accommodate all turns onto 17 Avenue SE.









### **Previous Council Direction**

 In March 2020, Calgary Planning Commission approved Outline Plan LOC2018-0275 which requires the developer to construct the new alignment of 84 Street south of 17 Avenue SE.



# Highlights

### **Access Bylaw & Relocation**

This report asks Council to approve a bylaw to close the identified public road access to a private property, and direct Administration to upgrade a different access point further east on the property.





## **Reasons for Recommendation**

The subject parcel landowner and the adjacent developer have been in discussion for several years but have been unable to reach agreement.





The City has the authority to close a public access by bylaw under the *Highways Development and Protection Act*.

Land development in the area is proceeding but this issue remains unresolved.





Administration wishes to upgrade the secondary access to the property to preserve all-turn access onto 17 Avenue SE.

### Recommendations

- 1. Give three readings to the proposed Bylaw to remove the existing all-turns access for 8775 17 Avenue SE onto 17 Avenue SE (Attachment 1); and
