## **BACKGROUND**

At its meeting held 2002 October 29, the Nominating and Agenda Committee adopted the Recommendations contained in report AOC01-41.

A suggestion is that guidelines be prepared and approved by Council which includes:

- Recognition of only those members of Council who are departing (whether it be retiring, not running for re-election or electoral defeat
- What form of recognition, if any, there will be for Members of Council who depart mid term prior to the completion of an election cycle.

# **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this policy is to formalize and clarify practices on the recognition of departing Members of Council

# **POLICY**

That departing members of Council be recognized with a formal ceremony and gift presented by Members of Council and supported by the Administration.

# **PROCEDURE**

- The Mayor will host an acknowledgement function (lunch/dinner/reception) a few months following the election for those Members of Council who have departed.
- Current Members of Council will be invited to attend.
- Funds required for the dinner/reception will be placed in the City Clerk's budget during the third year of the election term.
