






Highlights

- Development Phase progressing on schedule
- Beltline and Downtown utility work resumed after planned pause for Stampede
- 78 Avenue Project awarded to Graham Construction and construction commenced on July 26
- Risk Management Process audit presented to Audit Committee
- City's Spring Pulse Survey showed that 92% of Calgarians support Green Line





Development Phase



- Onboarding and co-location of Green Line and BTC teams completed
- Governance structure established
- Multiple Technical and Functional Working Groups in place and functioning
- Design progressing and related submittals mapped to reach 30% by January 2024
- Supplemental field data collection underway
- Procurement of key subcontractors proceeding
- Developing and refining assumption on quantities, means and methods, production rates, schedule, risks and costs

Health & Safety	From April to July, three incidents occurred resulting in property damage with no injuries. The root causes of these incidents include incorrect utility locates, and physical condition of historical infrastructure.
Environment	Environmental Site Assessments (ESA) were completed in March and there are no new updates to report.
Stakeholder Relations	Connected with 1,131 businesses, residents, and key interest holders from April - July.
Schedule	 Phase 1 DBF-DP RFP activities are on schedule. BDURP construction key milestones are on schedule.
Cost	 Green Line continues to proactively monitor program costs. Appropriate mitigation measures for key risks continue to be identified and implemented.






