Background




Nominations Committee ("the Committee") was established by Council resolution on 2016 April 25.



The Committee's mandate is to consider and recommend applicants for Council to appoint to BCCs.



Council Policy CP2016-03 on the *Governance and Appointments of Boards, Commissions and Committees* ("the Policy") has governed the work of the Committee.



Highlights

- Continues the Committee as a Standing Specialized Committee of Council through amendments to the Procedure Bylaw
- Will improve alignment with requirements in the Municipal Government Act for municipal councils to establish council committees, and their functions and procedures, by bylaw.
- Updates to the Policy improve alignment between the Policy and the practices that Board, Commission and Committee Chairs and the Committee rely upon to short list candidates.
