Background

Fleet Management enables City services and external partners by providing reliable and efficient vehicles and equipment that maximize safety, environmental sustainability, and minimize lifecycle costs. Fleet Management is also responsible for green and safe driver training, vehicle and equipment maintenance, fabrication and repair, asset management, fuel management, and green fleet initiatives.

Fleet Management provides a range of vehicles and equipment which includes light duty vehicles, sanders, refuse trucks, snowplows, and construction equipment. These vehicles and equipment enhance the mobility of staff, may act as mobile offices, and enable the delivery of services to Calgarians. Fleet Management relies almost entirely on borrowing funds to acquire the vehicles necessary for the City's various business units to deliver their services effectively. The vehicle acquisitions are in accordance with the capital budget first approved by Council.
