 - 23 low risk
 - 6 elevated risk
 - 0 high risk
- Risk mitigation strategies in place.









Governance and risk management

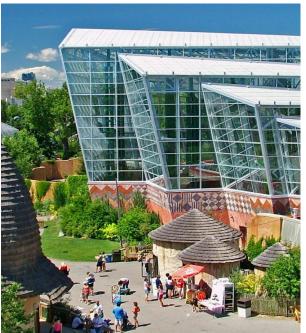
Governance: Policies & practices continue to evolve including improved approaches to embed equity, diversity & inclusion.
