



REVISED NOTICE OF MOTION

RE: Implementation of Residential Parking Permit Fees

WHEREAS The Residential Parking Permit program was reviewed over 2019-2020 to increase financial sustainability, improve customer service and consistency, better use street space and support the objectives of the Municipal Development Plan and Calgary Transportation Plan;

AND WHEREAS the approved changes to the Residential Parking Permit program move the program in alignment with Council's User Fees and Subsidies policy;

AND WHEREAS the 2022 fee schedule for residential parking permits is no charge for standard permits, visitor permits or select permits, with the exception of the third permit at a cost of \$54.45 per year;

AND WHEREAS Council approved a fee schedule in 2022 November to achieve full user pay to cover the costs of administering the Residential Parking Permit program beginning in 2023;

AND WHEREAS Administration has completed substantial work to implement the approved fees for 2023 August 01;

AND WHEREAS Permit holders have been informed of the upcoming fee schedule;

AND WHEREAS Permit holders have provided substantial feedback to indicate the implementation of the approved fee schedule is burdensome given the amount and time frame;

AND WHEREAS Administration has received over 180 requests for signage reviews from residents who feel the service is no longer necessary;

AND WHEREAS extending the transition period for implementing the fee schedule will allow for signage reviews to be completed and for residents to prepare for the incoming fees;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that City Council directs Administration to extend the transition period to allow for adequate time for signage review so that the approved fees take effect on 2023 December 04.

AND FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that Council direct Administration to bring back an update on permit uptake, budget implications and recommended future fee schedule to support transition to full user pay of the program as part of the 2023 November Business Plan and Budget adjustments.
