EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The City Clerk's Office received a Citizen's expression of interest in becoming a member of the Access Calgary Eligibility Appeal Board. Council may wish to appoint a Citizen to fill the current vacancy for a Member with Disability, Using Specialized Transportation Services for the completion of a one-year term to expire at the 2014 Organizational Meeting of Council.

ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDATION(S)

That Council:

- 1. Appoint Ms. Kathryn MacLeod as a member with disability using specialized transportation services to serve on the Access Calgary Eligibility Appear Board for the remainder of a one-year term to expire at the 2014 Organizational Meeting of Council; and
- 2. Direct that Report C2013-0847 remain confidential under Section 17(1) of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act until Council rises and reports.
- 3. Direct that Attachment 1 remain confidential pursuant to Section 17(1) of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL DIRECTION POLICY

At the 2013 November 4 Organizational Meeting of Council, Council appointed four Members to the Access Calgary Eligibility Appeal Board with terms to expire in 2014 October, and adopted the following:

"That, with respect to the Access Calgary Eligibility Appeal Board, one position for a Citizen who is a member with disability using specialized transportation services, remain vacant, to be appointed at a later date".

BACKGROUND

The Access Calgary Eligibility Appeal Board hears and determines appeals from those persons deemed to be ineligible for Access Calgary services. The Access Calgary Eligibility Appeal Board reports to the Standing Policy Committee on Transportation and Transit.

The full composition for the Access Calgary Eligibility Appeal Board is five members. Membership should consist of two citizens who are members with disabilities using specialized transportation services, two citizens who are health care practitioners (e.g. Medical Doctor, Occupational or Physical Therapist, Rehabilitation Specialist) and one citizen-at-large. Members are appointed for one year terms, set to expire at the 2014 Organizational Meeting of Council.

ACCESS CALGARY ELIGIBILITY APPEAL BOARD – MEMBER VACANCY AND APPOINTMENT

The current membership in the Access Calgary Eligibility Appeal Board was established at the 2013 November 4 Organizational Meeting of Council. The composition is as follows:

- Mrs. Angela Goertzen Health Care Practitioner;
- Ms. Donna Hreys Health Care Practitioner;
- Ms. Alison Lievers Citizen-at-large;
- Mr. Scott Herron Member with Disability, Using Specialized Transportation Services; and
- Vacant Member with Disability, Using Specialized Transportation Services.

The quorum for any meeting of the Access Calgary Eligibility Board is three members. The Access Calgary Eligibility Appeal Board meets every third Tuesday of the month. The next Access Calgary Eligibility Appeal Board meeting is scheduled to be held on 2013 December 17.
