Proposed amendments to improve efficiency in the appointment process in the following areas:

#### 1. Application process

Candidates apply using one application form, with prescribed questions, for up to two Boards, Commissions or Committees

#### 2. Reserve list

Consistent creation and mandatory rather than optional provision

#### 3. Nominations Committee

Establishment and continuation in an Election year, with the exception of the months of September and October



## TERM LIMIT AND MAXIMUM

# **Current Council policy:**

A Public Member may serve up to a maximum of six consecutive years on a City BCC, unless otherwise outlined in a City BCC's Governance Document(s)

## **Proposed Amendment:**

The years served on a City BCC prior to 2016 April 25 will be counted in the calculation of the Public Member's length of service
