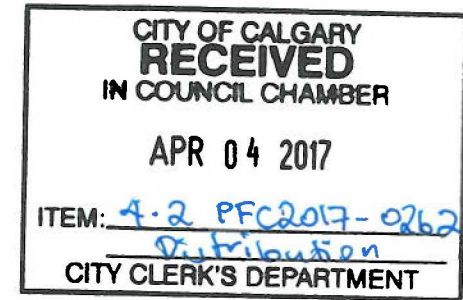

Costs Associated with Responding to FOIP Requests – 2016 Q3 – Q4 Report



Background



The City of Calgary, a public body under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, must respond to all formal FOIP access to information requests made for records in the custody or control of The City of Calgary.

The City Clerk's FOIP Office is accountable for responding to all FOIP Requests.

At Regular Meeting of Council on 2013 March 18,

- Administration be directed to routinely disclose information wherever possible on a cost-recovery basis; and
- Further provide information in response to NM2013-09 which is identified in the Attachments to PFC2017-0262;
- FOIP Office coordinates the gathering of this information from the Departments and Business Units on a semi-annual basis.

Recommendations

That the Priorities and Finance Committee recommends that Council:

- Receive this report for information; and,
- Direct the City Clerk's FOIP Office to discontinue forwarding FOIP statistical reports to Council and instead, proactively disclose the information and publish the reports on Calgary.ca semi-annually.
