Developing a New Civic Partnership Program (EC2022-1378)


- Establish a Civic Partner Operating Grant Program that aligns with current & future Council directions.

- Use the approved terms of reference & framework to adjust the allocation of grant funding from 2024 to 2026.
- Report back annually to Council through existing accountability reports & Civic Partner annual reports

Calgary Recommendations


That the Community Development Committee recommend that Council:

The Civic Partner Operating Grant Program provides a structured, transparent & consistent approach for operating grant funding recommendations for Civic Partners.




Terms of Reference are based on research into leading practices & engagement with Civic Partners, members of Council & Administration.

- Limited opportunity to communicate impact.


