- Direct that Closed Meeting Discussions and all Confidential Attachments be held confidential pursuant to sections 17 (Disclosure harmful to personal privacy), 19 (Confidential evaluations) and 23 (Local public body confidences) of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.
