





- Allows additional discretionary use of Community Recreation Facility within the existing building

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



DIRECT CONTROL DISTRICT

Purpose

1 This Direct Control District Bylaw is intended to allow for the additional use of a community recreation facility.

Compliance with Bylaw 1P2007

2 Unless otherwise specified, the rules and provisions of Parts 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Bylaw 1P2007 apply to this Direct Control District Bylaw.

Reference to Bylaw 1P2007

Within this Direct Control District Bylaw, a reference to a section of Bylaw 1P2007 is deemed to be a reference to the section as amended from time to time.

Permitted Uses

4 The permitted uses of the Residential – Contextual One Dwelling (R-C1) District of Bylaw 1P2007 are the permitted uses in this Direct Control District.

Discretionary Uses

- 5 (1) The discretionary uses of the Residential Contextual One Dwelling (R-C1) District of Bylaw 1P2007 are the discretionary uses in this Direct Control District.
 - (2) The following use is an additional discretionary use when the use is located within a building that exists on the date of passage of this Direct Control District Bylaw:
 - (a) Community Recreation Facility.
