# **Proposed Land Use Change Applicant Summary**

#### APPLICATION SUMMARY

The subject site is home to a newly constructed 17 West building. On behalf of Truman Homes, CivicWorks has submitted a Land Use Redesignation (rezoning) application to update the existing Direct Control District rules of the 17 West site by including a new use - *Small Format Digital Sign*. Truman is not proposing any changes to the 17 West building or the built form rules in the Direct Control District.

### DIRECT CONTROL DISTRICT

Truman recently received Development Permit approval to install a Class E: Digital Message Sign on the southwest corner facade of 17 West; and plan to install in a small high quality LED sign which will initially be used to advertise units through the Temporary Sales Centre. The proposed change to the Direct Control rules would allow for this sign to stay in the same location to advertise local businesses both in the building and elsewhere after the Temporary Sales Centre is closed. The proposed Direct Control District rules will require that this sign remains small scale ( $\leq 5m^2$ ), stays in the same location on the SW facade of the building, and follows the City's standard hours of operations for digital displays (7:00am-10:00pm).
