
## Medical Response Unit Pilot Project Update

| 2     | MRUs at Downtown Station 1 and Forest<br>Heights Station 12                                 |

| 24/7  | MRUs are staffed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week with 2 firefighters (A Lieutenant & Driver). |
| 2,640 | Incidents responded to by MRUs.   |

| 0:12 | Improvement to Medical Calls within assigned district.                              |

| 1:27 | Response Time Improvement to Building<br>Structure Fires by Engines within District |

| 11% | Improvement in unit availability in Station 01's district. (Meaning another unit didn't have to travel to cover incidents.)           |

| 158 | During 158 incidents, the district engine was able to respond in District 12 & 01 as the MRU had already responded to a medical call. |
| 7   | Available engines were available to respond to 7 confirmed fires.   |
| 19  | Available engines were available to respond to 19 hazardous materials incidents.  |
| 7   | MRUs were the first-on scene and administered a life saving automated external defibrillator (AED) during 7 incidents.                |
