Terms of Reference

- Calgary Public Library's Audit Committee was created in 2012
- The Terms of Reference were to:
 - Review and direct external and internal audit reports
 - Oversee risk direction at Calgary Public Library
- Effective 2015, financial oversight has been added to the Committee's terms of reference, and the Committee was renamed the Audit & Finance Committee



Overview of Planned Governance Activities

Two Committees focus on governance

- Governance Committee guides and enhances the Board's governance practices
- Audit & Finance Committee planned activities:
 - Oversee the risk management function of the Calgary Public Library
 - Review budget preparation and financial performance
 - Receive the annual external audit plan
 - Receive and review the audited financial statements and auditor's report on the year's financial performance
 - Review operational audits performed periodically to internally benchmark and assess if work functions within the Calgary Public Library are matching best practices

Overview of Risk Management Process

- The Library uses a proactive, continuous process to identify and minimize risk
- Board Policy Risk Management provides high level direction on risk management
- Board's Audit & Finance Committee reviews audit and risk factors and is responsible for evolution of Risk Framework
- Quarterly review of risk measures by Board's Audit & Finance Committee in place
- Risk management consistently applied to development and implementation of policy, programs, plans and future directions



Overview of Internal Control Environment

- The Library Board has full management and control of the Library, with policies used to provide direction for decisions and actions by Board, management and staff
- The CEO is accountable to the Board, and Library staff are accountable to the CEO
- A comprehensive set of Board Policies (currently under review by the Governance Committee) sets the tone of the internal control environment
- All internal processes are fully documented, actively monitored, and continuously updated as changes occur



Summary of External Auditors' Report

- Unqualified opinion was issued on the financial statements
- No restrictions placed on the scope of the audit
- No areas of non-compliance with laws and regulations identified
- No misstatements
- No disclosure deficiencies
- No instances of management overriding controls
- No significant weaknesses in internal control identified
- Accounting estimates are free of management bias and material misstatement



Commentary on 2014 Statements

- Major reconciling items occur in reporting of:
 - Tangible capital assets and depreciation on those assets
 - Repayment of debt
 - Presentation of surplus and accumulated surplus
- The Library ended 2014 with a small unrestricted surplus



Key 2015 Initiatives

- Bring the Library into more People's Lives
 - Extend library hours and enhance the library's digital presence
 - Deploy mobile devices, new program designs, and additional vehicles
 - Enhance information services through digital device lending
- Strengthening Neighbourhoods in a Growing City
 - Revitalize library facilities
 - Open a Transit-oriented library location at Westbrook
 - Implement the Library2Go mini-bookmobile
- Focus on Services that Make a Difference
 - Foster development of early literacy skills
 - Enhance services for students and newcomers
 - Broaden the summer reading experience by integrating a virtual component
