

Background and Previous Council Direction

Background

The Council Community Fund (CCF) provides non-repayable financial support for community-based projects that improve quality of life in Calgary. For the purposes of the CCF, “community based” means “A project that is organized locally, takes place locally and benefits the local community.” CCF applications may be for amounts up to \$500,000 and must be sponsored by a member of Council. The Council Community Fund Terms of Reference requires that successful applicants submit an update report indicating how the Council Community Fund grant was spent and the outcomes of the project.
