Proposed Text for a Bylaw to amend Bylaw 25M2002, the Emergency Management Bylaw

- 1. Bylaw 25M2002, the Emergency Management Bylaw, as amended, is hereby further amended.
- 2. In section 5:
 - (a) subsection 5(2)(b) is deleted and replaced with the following:
 - "(b) the administrative head of the following Business Units or Divisions or their identified representative for emergency management purposes:
 - (i) Animal & Bylaw Services;
 - (ii) Calgary Police Service;
 - (iii) Calgary Fire Department;
 - (iv) Calgary Transit;
 - (v) Community & Neighbourhood Services;
 - (vi) Corporate Properties;
 - (vii) Corporate Security;
 - (viii) Customer Service & Communications;
 - (ix) Inspections & Permit Services;
 - (x) Fleet Services;
 - (xi) Human Resources;
 - (xii) Information Technology;
 - (xiii) Infrastructure & Information Services;
 - (xiv) Law Department;
 - (xv) Parks;
 - (xvi) Public Safety Communications;
 - (xvii) Roads;
 - (xviii) Supply Management;
 - (xix) Waste & Recycling Services;
 - (xx) Water Resources;
 - (xi) Water Services."
 - (b) subsection 5(3) is deleted and replaced with the following:
 - "(3) In addition to the members appointed by subsection (2), the following organizations shall be invited by the Director to nominate representatives to serve as members of the Agency:
 - (a) Alberta Emergency Management Agency;
 - (b) Alberta Energy Regulator;
 - (c) Alberta Environment and Sustainable Resource Development;
 - (d) Alberta Health Services Administration;
 - (e) Alberta Health Services Emergency Medical Services (EMS);
 - (f) Alberta Health Services Medical Officer of Health;

- (g) ATCO Gas;
- (h) Building Owners and Managers Association
- (i) Calgary Airport Authority;
- (j) Calgary Board of Education;

- (n) Calgary Zoo;
- (o) ENMAX Power Corporation;
- (p) Environment Canada;
- (q) Southern Francophone School Board #4;

- 3. Section 6(1) is deleted and replaced with the following:
 - "6 (1) The Director is appointed by the General Manager, Community Services and Protective Services."
- 4. (1) This Bylaw comes into force on the day it is passed.
 - (2) Despite subsection 4(1), section 3 comes into force on January 1, 2015.
