## Calgary Metropolitan Region Board – March 2024 Land Use and Servicing Committee Meeting Update

---

### PURPOSE OF BRIEFING

The purpose of this briefing is to update the Intergovernmental Affairs Committee on the work of the Calgary Metropolitan Region Board (CMRB) from their Land Use and Servicing Committee (the Committee) held on 2024 March 14.

### SUPPORTING INFORMATION

Councillor Gian-Carlo Carra represented The City of Calgary at the meeting.

The Committee received a presentation from the University of British Columbia's Housing Assessment Resource Tool (HART) Project team on the draft Calgary Metro Region Housing Needs Assessment. The assessment was developed by HART for the CMRB to support a regional application to Infrastructure Canada's Permanent Public Transit Fund. The assessment measures and categorizes core housing needs and affordable shelter costs by income, household size, and priority populations. The Committee recommended the draft assessment to the Board for approval.

The Committee received a presentation from the Land and Environmental Planning division of Environment and Protected Areas (Province of Alberta) on the draft Springbank Off-stream Reservoir Project Land Use Plan. The presentation's function was to build outreach and awareness of the draft plan and was received for information by the Committee.

CMRB administration updated the Committee on the scoping of the Regional Transportation and Transit Master Plan. The Transportation and Transit Technical Advisory Group, consisting of subject matter experts from member municipalities and CMRB Administration, has been meeting on a regular basis to refine the draft project charter.

The Committee received a verbal update from CMRB Administration on drought response. The Water Technical Advisory Group has been discussing drought response with member municipalities.
