






In 2023, Springbank Airport was a key base for wildfire response, hosting aircraft for operations in Banff, Kananaskis and surrounding areas.







Red 6, was officially placed into service in 2023.




WEST RUNWAY



Implemented a waste reduction strategy, introduced composting, updated waste signage, and enforced a single-use plastics ban in concessions.


Environmental stewardship enhancements


