

Report Back: What We Heard

March 2024

Project Overview

The City of Calgary received a naming application for a new park, in the northeast community of Saddle Ridge (39 Saddlepeace Way NE). The City solicited feedback from citizens living in Saddle Ridge and neighbouring communities regarding naming the park "Guru Teg Bahadur Park", as proposed by the applicant.

The naming of public assets in Calgary is regulated by The City's *Municipal Naming, Sponsorship, and Naming Rights Policy*. City Assets are most commonly named in response to applications from external parties. Naming proposals that meet minimum community support requirements and basic policy criteria undergo broader public engagement to solicit input from impacted communities. If no substantial concerns are raised during the public engagement, the asset steward prepares a report with naming recommendation for Council, which makes the final decision regarding the asset naming.

Engagement Overview

The City solicited feedback from the residents of Saddle Ridge and neighbouring communities on this naming proposal. Public engagement was conducted online on The City of Calgary Engage webpage over a three-week period, from November 7 to November 28, 2023. There were 3,679 visitors to the Engage webpage, with 509 participants providing feedback.

Engagement was advertised using paid social media targeting Saddle Ridge and surrounding communities. Sandwich board signage was also installed in the park during the engagement campaign, inviting park visitors to comment on The City's Engage webpage on the proposed park naming.

What we asked

Online engagement questions:

- 1. How do you feel about this park being named "Guru Teg Bahadur Park" as proposed by the applicant? Please tell us why?
- 2. What do you like about this naming proposal? Please tell us why?
- 3. What do you dislike about this naming proposal? Please tell us why?
- 4. Please provide us with the first three (3) letters of your POSTAL CODE.

What we Heard

Responses received from the participants are grouped in the chart below into six emerging themes and are accompanied by sample verbatim responses reflective of each theme. A full set of all verbatim comments in their entirety is included in the "Verbatim Comments" section at the end of this report.

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Theme	Sample Comments Reflective of the Theme
1. Some respondents highlight a sense of pride, connection, and appreciation for the opportunity to have a park that reflects their religious identity and roots.	"Would absolutely love it. Guru Teg Bahadur had a huge impact on all Sikhs and their history. We would not be here today if it wasn't for his heroics."
	"This name proposal is a great idea to persevere the culture and belongings of our community, Canada is a multicultural country and I believe all the cultures should have a sense of belongings in places where they live. Guru Teg Bahadur is known for good deeds, helping needy people, and made sacrifices for others. Children should know about such people."
	"This makes me feel appreciated as a member of Sikh community. It makes me remember the sacrifices that Guru Teg Bahadur ji made for the humanity."
	"I appreciate that this name is reflective on the communities values and commitments. This community is full of hardworking people who are committed to bring a positive change to north east Calgary. This naming proposal is effective in delivering that message and does an excellent job at encompassing the culture of the community and its contributions to the north east communities."
	"Hes our God. We feel so proud"
	"I will be very happy to name it as Guru Teg Bahadur Park. My kids are going to Govind server school. They will know about the lessons and values our ninth guru have given us. My kids will learn more about the sacrifices our tenth guru mede"

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"I am so glad applicant proposed this name, this is our guru's name. We all feel connected if we rename the park it's memorial park for us."

2. Some respondents highlight the admirable qualities and contributions of Guru Teg Bahadur, such as principles of, spirituality, poetry, martyrdom, and the fight for righteousness and religious freedom. The proposed naming is seen as a representation of these values, promoting themes of equality, peace, multiculturalism, and collaboration for the betterment of humanity.

"This will be greatly appreciated for the benefit of the citizens living in the surrounding areas to remind themselves of living to helping others as we are true brothers and sisters according to Guru Sahib's Statement of Truth, regardless of gender, colour, cast, or race. True Guru of the whole Humanity, Sri Guru Teg Bahadur ji have become an idol to all humanity how to sacrifice the Self for others with true love and happiness towards our Creator, Divine God. Very much thrilled to hear it."

"Guru Teg Bahadur is the ninth of ten Gurus of Sikhs. He was highly principled, spiritual scholar, poet, martyr and a fearless warrior who fought for righteousness and people's rights include the right to follow their religion by choice. I will be really glad if the park is named after such a great leader who embodies love and selfless service."

"Will promote equality, peace, multiculturalism"

"This naming will represent how to work together for the betterment of humanity."

"The purposed name is symbol of sacrifice and voice against oppression of innocent. This purposed name under the name of ninth guru(Guru Tegh Bahadur park) has history of self sacrifice. I feel positive about naming this park as I live near to this"

"We like this name because most people residing in that area are Punjabi/sikhi/Hindu. And many of them are from India where Sri Guru Dheg bahandar ji was from. He sacrificed himself for another religion, which is something no one else did."

"It's feel great to know that park in the community will named as Guru Teg Bahdur Park because Guru Teg Bahadur G was 9th Guru of Sikhs and he was symbol of unity and equal rights."

"I welcome this proposal as guru teg bahadur g is well known for his work for others."

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"It feels proud under our religious freedom fighter who saves other religions people lives and sacrifice himself."

"we will be so happy to have the requested name for the park. The name of the park will be the symbol of protection, Freedom, fearlessly lead a free life, Courage, sacrifice"

3. Some respondents express that proposed naming is reflective of demographic composition of the area, emphasizing the significant presence of Sikh residents. The proposed name is seen as a way to respect and appreciate the Sikh community, making residents feel valued and acknowledged.

"I feel really good about this name proposal, lots of Sikh communities live around this area and this name will make them feel respected and appreciated."

"I believe that will be the perfect name for the park considering the demographics in area and contribution of residents to community"

"Majority of the residents are from Punjab and Guru Teg Badadur is their Saint. Park name will help kids remember the history of Sikhism and the sacrifice Guru made."

"Yes, first and main reason is because the park is mostly intended for the use of children that study in Guru Nanak Gate Campus. Secondly people apart of the Sikh community would really appreciate this name because Guru Teg Bahadur Ji is the ninth Sikh guru."

"It's going to represent sikh community."

"This naming proposal to name the park under Guru Tech Bahadur Ji represents the local South Asian community of Saddleridge well."

"I appreciate that this name is reflective on the communities values and commitments. This community is full of hardworking people who are committed to bring a positive change to north east Calgary. This naming proposal is effective in delivering that message and does an excellent job at encompassing the culture of the community and its contributions to the north east communities."

"It would be great as the parks name is on the same Street Guru Nanak Gate"

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"Because the name Guru Teg Bahadur is a goddess for the sikhs
also the gobind sarvar school is right next to it"

"I love it! It is close to a Sikh-faith based school and the students visit the park regularly. It would be amazing to have it be named after one of our Gurus."

"I feel pretty good about this name because of guru sahib name. And specially this is located near gurudwara sahib and school."

4. Some respondents raise concern about potential racial tensions, division among communities, and a sense of exclusion for those who do not belong to the Sikh community. Some respondents are advocating for a more inclusive and neutral name that reflects the diversity of the community, emphasizing the need for unity and avoiding any association with a specific religion or ethnicity. The prevailing sentiment within this theme is against a name that could be perceived as exclusive or divisive.

"Not really great as this has nothing to do with Calgary or Saddlestone apart from the fact that it the name of a religious figure. Why name a park in the name of a Sikh religious figure when there are multitude of religions in the locality."

"I feel Saddleridge is a diverse community which represents people from different cultures and backgrounds so park should have a name which represents everyone not only one community since this name gives me an impression that this park is only for sikh community which is not fair with other community residents."

"Nothing, it's too racially challenging and will bring unwanted tension to the area."

"I disagree with the proposed name and suggest to choose a name which is not linked with any religion or community. Name must be selected based on services to humanity in broader context."

"I feel like this park is exclusive ONLY for Indian community."

"Name might trigger infight between communities- my thought. We should consider something that welcomes all."

"I've lived in this community for 7 years and I have kids. As a mom, I'm worried about potentially creating a sense of exclusion. Neutral name is more recommended from my own point of view."

"I dislike it and feel it's alienating to those who are not Sikh or spiritual in any way. It represents only one group and this is a public space for everyone."

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"There is already so much racism and segregation in this community. Naming it something that is related to the community not to a group of people...religion....or race. Saddleridge is becoming an Indian community but ot could be much more and more diverse. Name it something better. Stop the segregation."

"I know the neighborhood is heavily populated with minorities and they wish to name a park in our community after their religious heritage. I just think that you can't allow a community to get to saturated by one religion/people otherwise they don't integrate to their new community and you end up with little counties of India or China in the neighborhood instead of multicultural."

5. Some respondents express concerns about appropriateness of religious naming of public assets for various reasons, such as assigning a religious name to a public asset fails to honor the sanctity associated with that name, preference to secular nature when naming public assets, etc. The theme in these comments centers around opposition to naming public spaces after religious figures.

"Will not be liking any public property named for any religious leaders. This can be threat to others from other religions and can create violence."

"I don't think it's a well thought out name. Naming a park after a god is nice if everyone who were to visit it were to respect it for it's name. But it is a public park for everyone to use, not everyone going there will respect it. Some may intentionally cause damage or do disrespectful things there. Knowing that it is not able to be upheld to its honorable name and others may disrespect it, naming the park after a God is disrespectful."

"Not able to uphold the honor and purity that should follow the name. If there are drugs, disrespectful activites going on at the park which again isn't illegal since it is a public park. As a Sikh I'd find that very disrespectful to watch. Don't put yourself in situations you can't control after. Naming a park after a god in a public area where others can disrespect it and tarnish it is rather disrespectful."

"Not good. No religious displays should be allowed in a secular country"

"Do not see other parks named specifically for any religion. Therefore naming any public property for specific community/religion can create imbalance in communal harmony."

"No City property shall be named after any religious figure of any kind. This can lead to communal disharmony and demarcation of area by religion. Dividing a city by religion will be the final results.

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Such naming has long lasting affects. In coming days and years, more requests will come for Allah Park, Mohammed Baugh, Khalistan Garden, Ram Van, Jesus Ground or Mother Mary Garden/Park."

"It's based on a religious leader and it feels wrong to name a public park this. Many people live in this area that are and are not Sikh and it should be something that symbolizes everyone not just one group. There should be a very clear separation of religion and government/public spaces and services."

"Don't like it. Naming a city park after him, is an insult to the great Guru who has several gurudwaras named after him, in India..."

6. Some respondents comments convey a desire for a park name that reflects a more localized and inclusive history, preferably connected to individuals with ties to the community and who have made significant contributions in the context of Calgary or Canada.

"I believe this is wrong. There is no ties to Calgary, Alberta, or Canada. The fact it ignores all of the above is wrong. It is city land and thus should be named for someone with ties. It is not fair to only include one groups history."

"It doesn't appear that this person has any actual connection to Canada. He was the leader of a religious group but was never in Canada. If parks are going to be named after someone, especially if it's a religious affiliation, there should at least be a more direct connection to Canada."

"Guru Teg Bahadur was a religous figure in the 17th century in the Punjab. While this is of significance to the Sikh community and I am sure he is revered I fail to see his relevance to present day Calgary. I am sure that there are other Sikhs in the community that are worthy of having this park named after them."

"I would have preferred naming of a more recent historical figure from the same community."

"The name of this park is not ethnically diverse. If you want an ethnically charged name for the park choose a name that is not associated with religion but rather a real Canadian hero who was also an immigrant. Like Manmeet Bhullar...a pillar of the community."

"Doesn't feel good. He was a religious leader in India. Don't know how it relates here."

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"Park should be named after a local hero. And certainly not after a religious figure."

"In my opinion park should be named after in relation with something of Canada and Alberta. Or kept the same code what it was."

"Not very good to be blunt. There has to be a worthy Calgarian, Albertan, or Canadian this park could be named after."


"I'm not in favor of this name. Calgary parks should be names after Canadian people that have done things for Canadian people and or Calgarians. Guru Teg Bahadur died in India in the 1600's. A park should be inviting to everyone, not to be religious."

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Summary of Engagement Findings

Participant responses highlight both opportunities and challenges with giving religious naming to public spaces. A high-level summary of input is shared below.

Opportunities

- Naming parks after religions (religious leaders) honors the area's people, traditions, and history. It's a way of honoring some of the cultures and traditions that shaped the community.
- Naming after religious figures provides an opportunity to learn about different religions and their impact on local culture and history.

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Challenges

- Choosing a religious name may unintentionally favor or prioritize one religion, which could be seen as disrespectful or exclusive to people of different religions.
- Choosing religious names might overlook or diminish the cultural heritage and importance of certain groups or communities, like indigenous groups or other immigrant groups, that are also part of the area's history.

Next Steps

The feedback collected from this City-led engagement will help inform recommendations about this park naming.
