

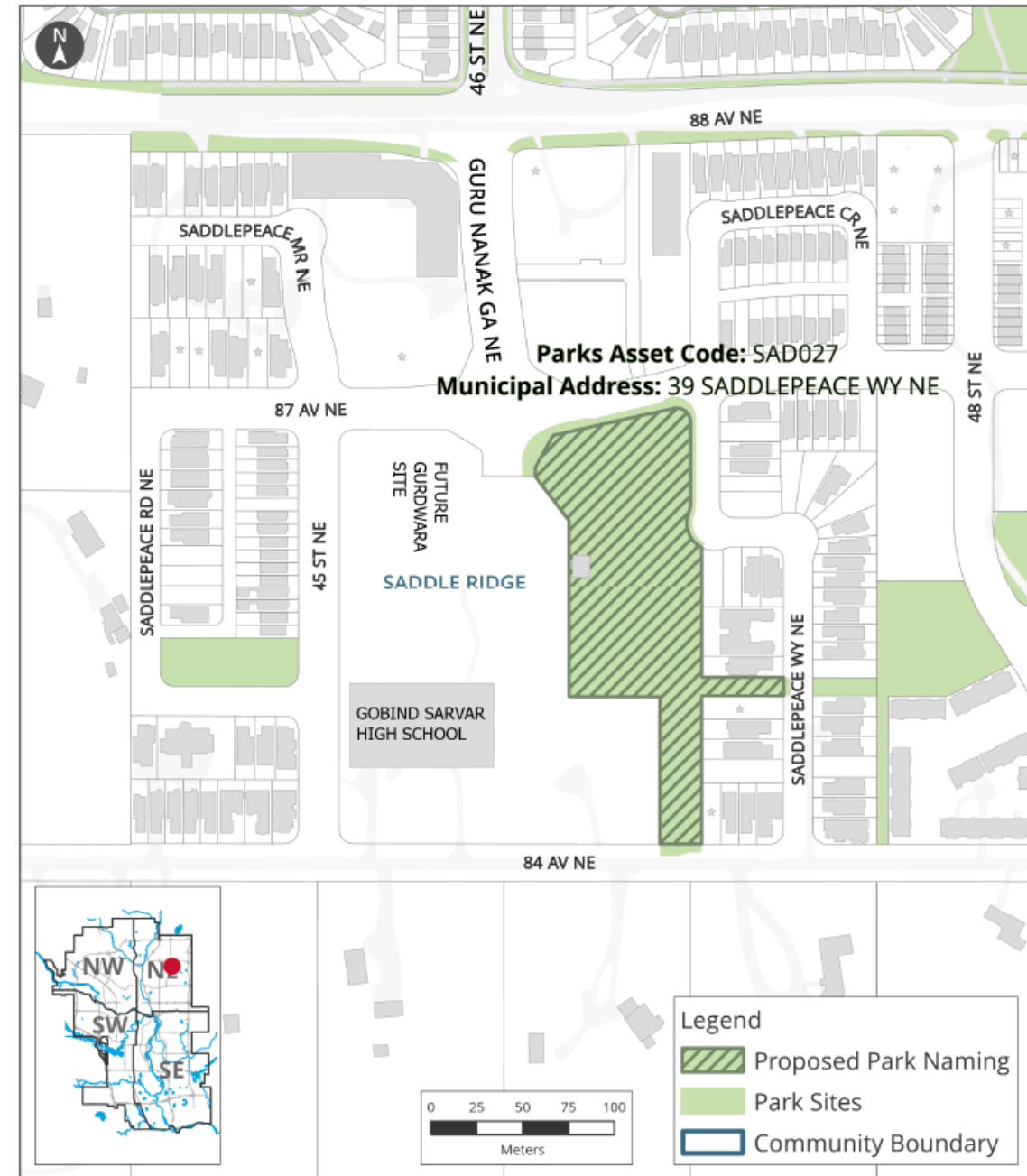


Park Naming: Saddle Ridge
