initiated land use redesignation specifically written to implement the vision and policies of the Chinook Station Area Plan. The proposed DC retains the rules of the existing land use and introduces an additional temporary use (up to five years) Beverage Container Drop-Off Depot within the existing building.

The subject site is located in the community of Manchester Industrial, east of the Chinook LRT station, on the north side of 61 Avenue SE. The surrounding lands include a mix of low rise and standalone commercial and industrial uses.

Administration recommends approval to the proposed land use district as it implements the policies of the Municipal Development Plan and allows for an interim temporary use to operate on the subject parcel while still encouraging future redevelopment that achieves the vision of the Chinook Station Area Plan.
