



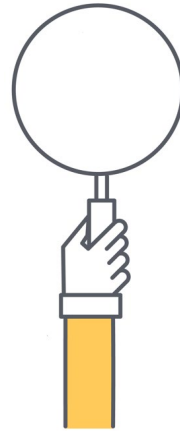

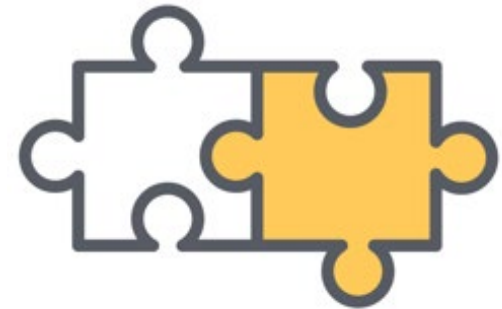
Mandate of the Social Wellbeing Advisory Committee

<p>Seek</p>	<p>Seek opportunities to support and grow culture in Calgary</p>
<p>Aim</p>	<p>Aim to stop social problems before they begin using a prevention approach</p>

Brought together representatives from 8 City of Calgary committees, and 2 different subcommittees for the third annual Inter-Committee Connections event



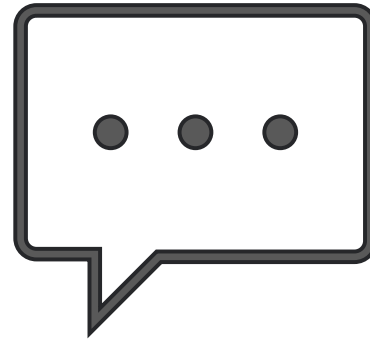
Increased transparency and awareness of the committee and its function among the public and community through updating both Committee and Subcommittee webpages
