Proposed Road Closure Conditions of Approval

- 1. All existing utilities within the road closure area shall be protected by easement or relocated at the developer's expense.
- 2. All existing access to the affected properties in the area shall be maintained or alternative access be constructed at the developer's expense.
- 3. Prior to submission of the affected Tentative Plan of subdivision, the developer shall enter into negotiations with Real Estate and Development Services for the purchase of the closed road right-of-way. Please contact the Coordinator, Real Estate Sales at realestateinquiries@calgary.ca to commence negotiations. Provide documentation to show that negotiations have commenced.
- 4. The developer is responsible for all costs associated with the closure including all necessary physical construction, removal, rehabilitation, utility relocation, etc.
- 5. The closed road right-of-way is to be consolidated with the adjacent lands.
- 6. Any utility rights-of-way are to be provided to the satisfaction of the Development Authority and the City Solicitor.
- 7. Utility easement are to be provided as required, with a utility Right-of-Way plan and an accompanying easement document is to be registered concurrently with the subdivision.
- 8. Relocation of any electrical and telecommunication installation are to be at the applicant's expense and to the appropriate standards.
