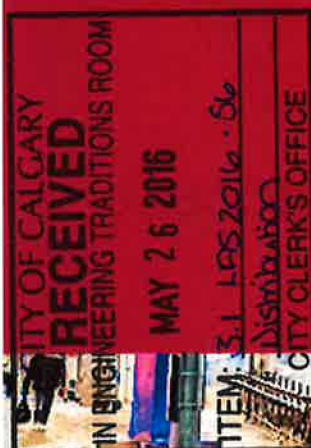

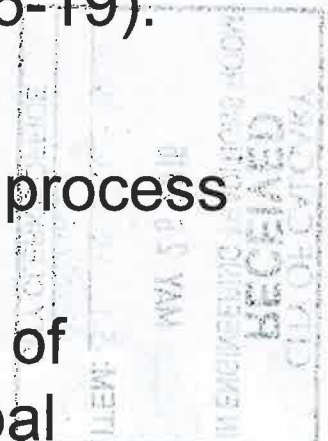

PURPOSE

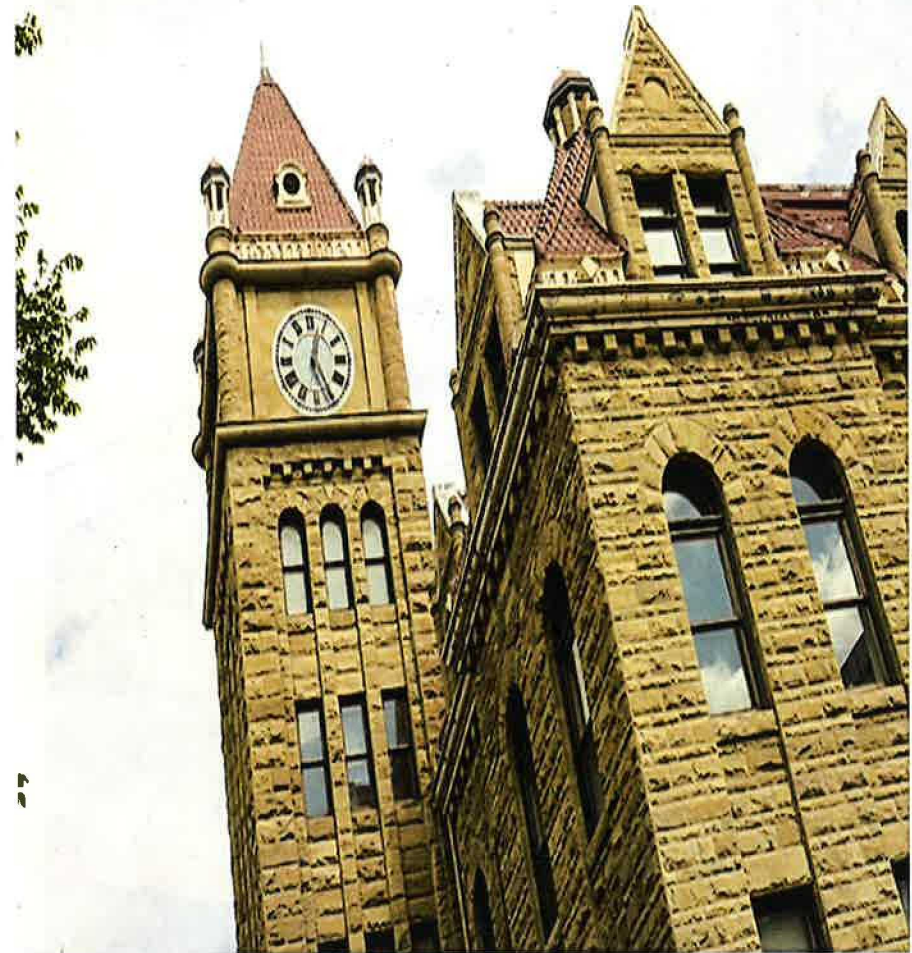
- I. Council Direction 2015 July 20 to develop a Municipal Complex Commemoration Policy based on approved principles (LAS2015-19).
- II. Establish an open, fair and transparent process to address requests from individuals or organizations proposing the installation of commemoration displays in the Municipal Complex.

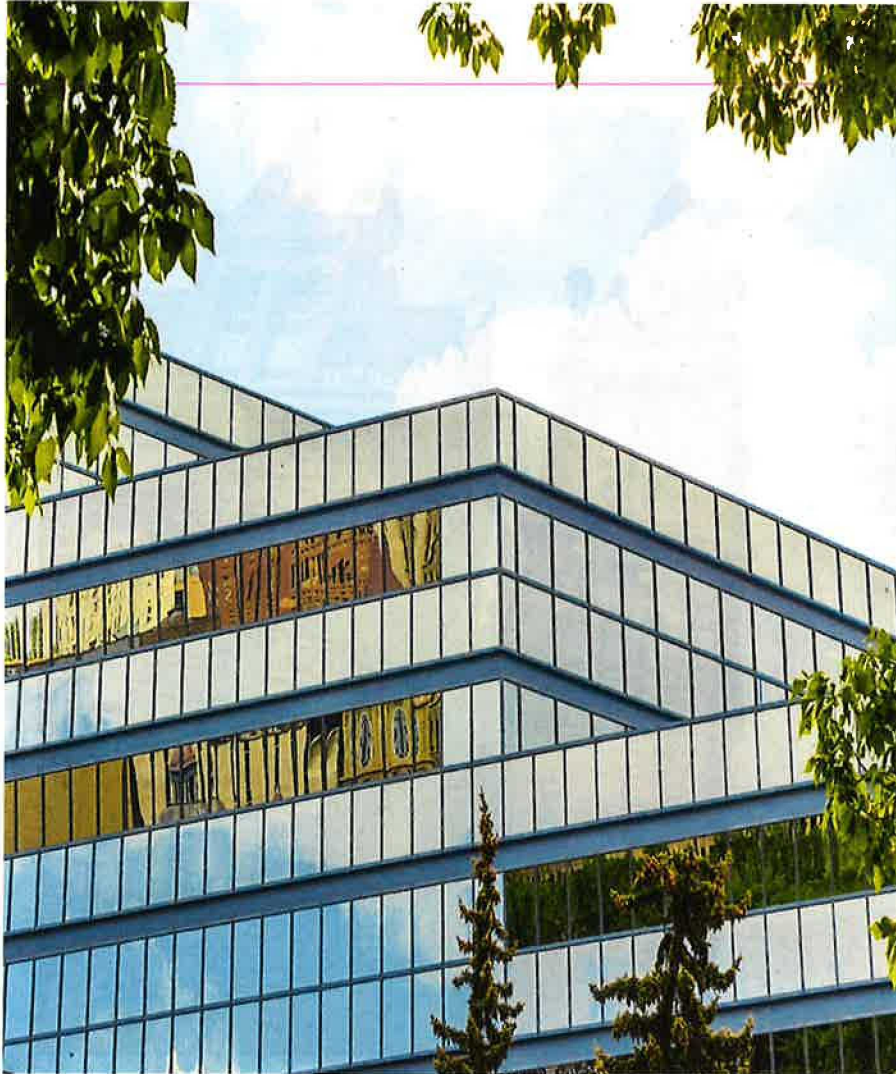




Analysis

Key Sections of Proposed Policy

- Temporary Displays
- Council Decision-Making Authority
- Timely review, evaluation and recommendation process
- Administration to work with successful applicants to enable installation, ceremony, maintenance and removal;
- Applicants responsible for costs of manufacture, installation, removal.

Risk Mitigation

- Reputation – mitigated through a comprehensive review and evaluation of commemoration applications;
- Operational Costs – monitoring and evaluating policy implementation will provide more information about the operational resources required.



Recommendation

That Land and Asset Strategy Committee recommends that Council adopt the Proposed Municipal Complex Commemoration Policy and Guidelines as set out in Attachment 1 and report back to Council through the Land and Asset Strategy Committee with recommended amendments, if required.
