Areas of interest/concern:
Height, Density, Amount of Parking, Lot coverage, Community character

What are the strengths and challenges of the proposed:
The Westbrook LAP does not indicate this type of development is appropriate for this area of Glendale.
The Citywide rezoning will not allow for this type of land use. We ask that RC-G at a maximum be considered for this area of Glendale to allow for the 'contextual' portion to still be considered.

Will the proposed change affect the use and enjoyment of your property? If so, how?
H-GO does not consider contextual and will impact the immediate neighboring properties. This does not fit in with the LAP transit proximity. Parking will be an issue.
