




## What is FCSS?



## Calgary Funding Recommendations

- \$2.1 million to 72 agencies as retroactive adjustment to base
- \$27.1 million to 74 agencies in 2016
- \$25.4 million to 54 agencies in 2017
- \$25.2 million to 47 agencies in 2018

## Recommendations

That the SPC on Community and Protective Services recommends to Council:

- Approve the funding allocations of \$2.1 million to 72 agencies using funds from the FCSS Stabilization Reserve;
- 2. Approve the 2016-2018 FCSS funding allocations of \$77.7 million
  - \$27.1 million to 74 agencies in 2016; \$25.4 million to 54 agencies in 2017 and \$25.2 million to 47 agencies in 2018 from Program 421;
- Authorize Administration to access up to \$500,000 from the FCSS Stabilization
  Reserve in 2016 for the purpose of funding agencies for one-time capacity building and emerging issues; and
- Consider this report as an item of Urgent Business at the 2016 January 25 regular Council meeting.
