Member	Reasons for Decision or Comments
Commissioner Hawryluk	 Administration is correct that, "The site is within 200 metres of Macleod Trail S which is identified as an Urban Main Street in the MDP. It is also within 200 metres of primary transit service and within 600 metres of an existing LRT platform. As such, the site meets the location criteria and is therefore considered appropriate for the proposed H-GO District" (Attachment 1, page 4). Council has set a goal that 95% of Calgarians will "live within 2000m of a dedicated transit facility (e.g. LRT, MAX bus station)" by 2050 (2022 Climate Strategy, pg. 19). This a reasonable goal because it encourages the coordination of land use planning and transportation planning. According to public transit and rail research consultant Dr. Willem Klumpenhouwer, 57% of Calgarians lived within 2000m (as the crow flies) of a dedicated transit facility in 2021 (see map below). Allowing more people to live in this location supports Council's direction.
