Dear Sir/Madam.

I am writing to express my deep concerns regarding the proposed land use change from single-family to multi-family at 327-30 NE Avenue in Calgary, Alberta. This proposed development raises several important issues that must be carefully considered:

Privacy Concerns for Neighbors: The proposed development could significantly impact the privacy of nearby residents. The increased density and close proximity of the new apartment buildings could result in increased noise and a loss of privacy in backyards and other common areas. Additionally, the height and location of the buildings could block sunlight in the mornings and make neighboring properties feel intrusive, while too many windows facing neighbors' backyards is also a serious privacy issue.

Over-Concentration of Multi-Family Housing: Our neighborhood already has two multi-family properties nearby, including an existing apartment building and a newly approved land re-designation for multi-family housing right next to this new proposal. This new proposal would further concentrate multi-family housing in the area, which could strain resources and negatively impact the character of the neighborhood.

Increased Density and Traffic: The proposed apartment buildings would increase density in the area. This could result in increased noise pollution, stress on existing infrastructure such as parks and public services, and a shortage of street parking. Increased traffic could also create greater risks for children walking to and from school or playing in nearby parks.

Loss of Community Character: Converting single-family homes to apartments will alter the established character of a neighborhood. This could negatively impact property values $\Box\Box$ and the overall quality of life for existing residents.

Environmental Concerns: New apartment buildings may have environmental impacts such as increased energy consumption, air movement, stormwater runoff, and potential impacts on wildlife habitat.

I urge you to carefully consider these issues and participate in a thorough review process to ensure that the proposed development is in the best interest of our community. I believe it is critical to find a balance between the need for housing and maintaining the quality of life in our community.
