

## Public Engagement Summary

As the Prairie Gateway Area Structure Plan (ASP) lands are within Rocky View County's (the County) jurisdiction, the County led and managed public engagement with City support. During the development of Prairie Gateway ASP, the County completed three Engagement Summary documents.

The public engagement was completed in two phases. Phase 1 occurred before a draft of the Prairie Gateway ASP was completed and released for public review and comment. Table 1 summarizes phase 1 public engagement and the information garnered from members of the public.
