Background and Previous Council Direction

This attachment provides background and previous Council direction related to the Civic Census.

Background

The City of Calgary previously conducted a municipal census. The Civic Census was an official count of dwelling units and the population who are living in these units, by the door-to-door physical collection (and later, online) collecting of data.

The City of Calgary first conducted a municipal census in 1931 and continued periodically until 1958 when the frequency was increased to an annual count of population until 2019.

Bylaws, Regulations, Council Policies

The <u>Municipal Government Act</u> allows municipalities to conduct a census (see Section 57). Requirements to conduct a census are contained within Municipal Census Regulation (2023) and the Municipal Census Manual (2022).

Information during a census must be collected, used, disclosed, protected, retained and disposed of in accordance with the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*.
