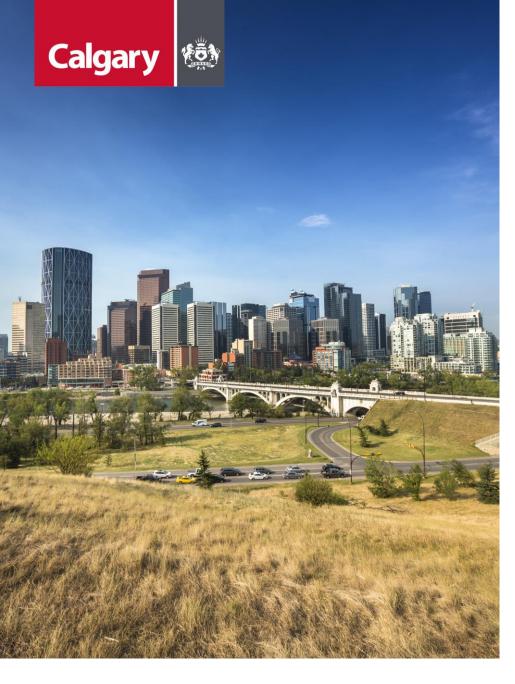

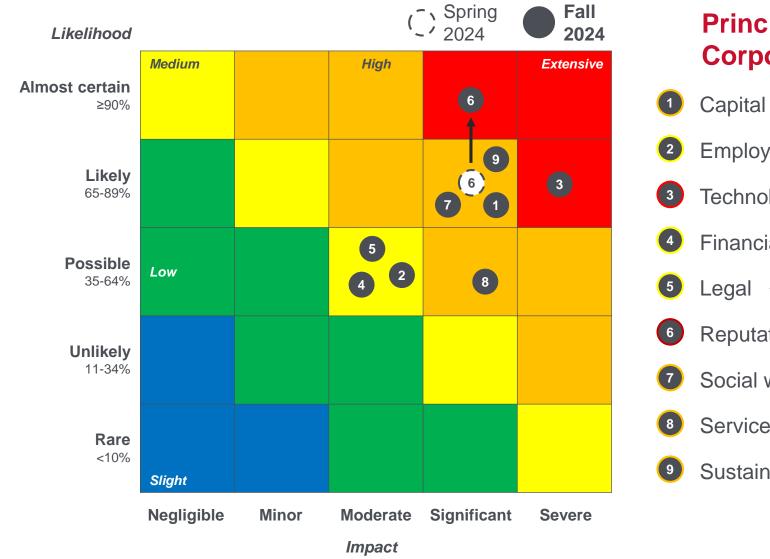
2024 Mid-Year Update.

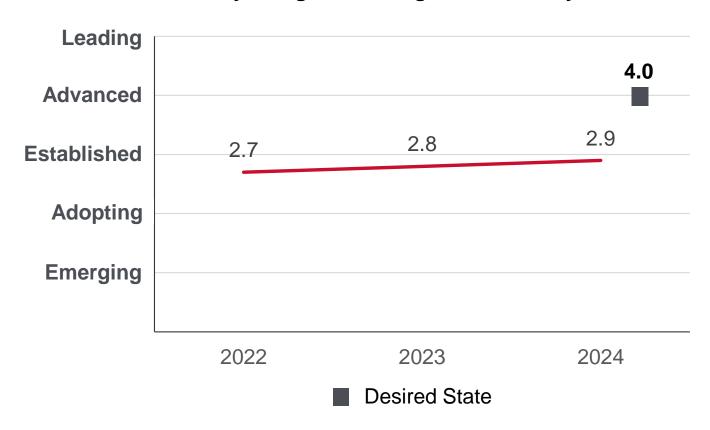

# Calgary (2024)**Average Risk Maturity** Score

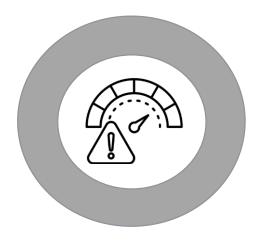
