Calgary 🐼 Updates on progress



- The waste officer role has been permanently filled
- The interdepartmental working group has been formed
- Land use Bylaw updates were made in 2023
- Coordinated inspections and enforcement have been successful in addressing historically non-compliant sites
- Removed 23,000 tonnes of waste material from sites

Calgary 🐼 Review of Business Licence Bylaw Changes



- No additional enforcement tools needed at this time
- Would require operational changes for all waste and recycling sites (including compliant sites)
- Relying on Land use Bylaw and Fire Code is effective

Calgary 🖄 Ongoing Actions and Next Steps

- Continued advocacy efforts with Government of Alberta
- Ongoing communication with site operators to ensure compliance
- Ongoing inspections and enforcement activities at private waste sites
- Development of a guide for waste and recycling site operators
