





### BEARSPAW RESERVOIR TRILATERAL TASK FORCE











# Public Lands Administration Regulation (AR 187/2011).

The following activities are exempt from the requirement for an approval:

(a) placing, constructing, installing, maintaining, using, replacing or removing a seasonal pier, boat launch or dock in or adjacent to a water body, including cutting, installing or maintaining a floating platform or a portable or seasonal dock; removing invasive aquatic plants in accordance with the applicable disturbance and balance standards established under section 3 of the Public Lands Administration Regulation (AR 187/2011).

This excerpt is from Public Lands Administration Regulation (AR 187/2011). It outlines exemptions from the requirement for an approval for certain activities related to placing, maintaining, or removing docks or piers in or near a water body.
